



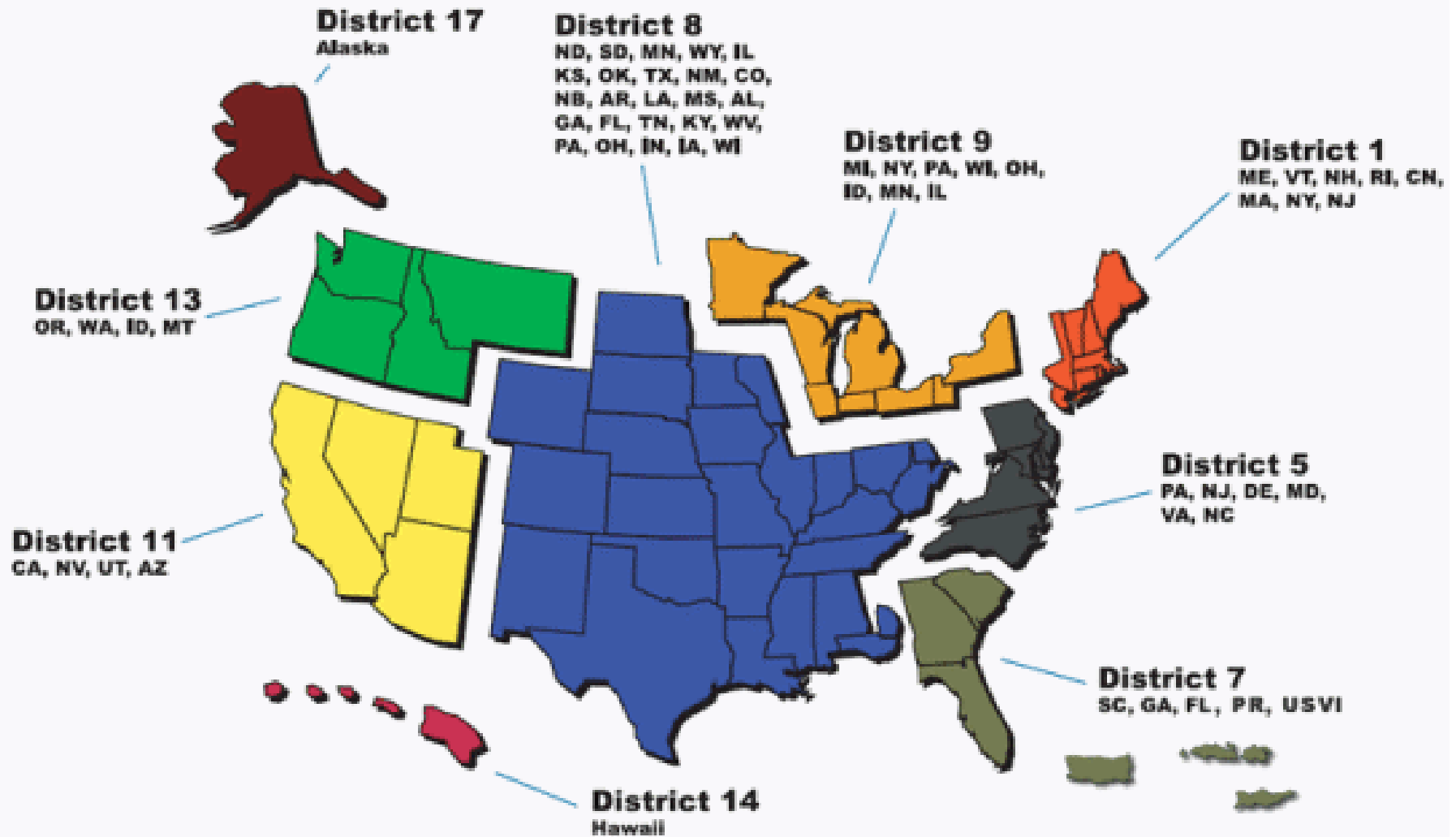

North Carolina By the Numbers



Annually, Sector NC performs:

Safety

- 266 SAR cases
- 87 lives saved
- 437 lives assisted
- \$12M property assisted/saved
- 775 vessel inspections

Security

- 2245 LE Activities
- 63 Terminations
- 158 Warnings Issued
- 132 Violations Issued
- 119 facility inspections
- 711 ATON serviced
- 57 EHS Load Outs, 28 million net explosive weight

- 95 pollution responses

Assets

- 8 Small Boat Stations

Cases

- Rescue of four divers off the Cape Fear River
- Rescue of family on sailboat near Morehead City during Tropical Storm Ophelia
- Blue Fin Tuna Operation





Pollution Response



Mission

- Prevent, mitigate, and enforce oil and hazardous material discharges into U.S. Waters

Responses

- 96 Pollution Responses to NRC Reports
- 11 Enforced Pollution Cases
- 6 Federal Projects, total of \$85K in federal funds



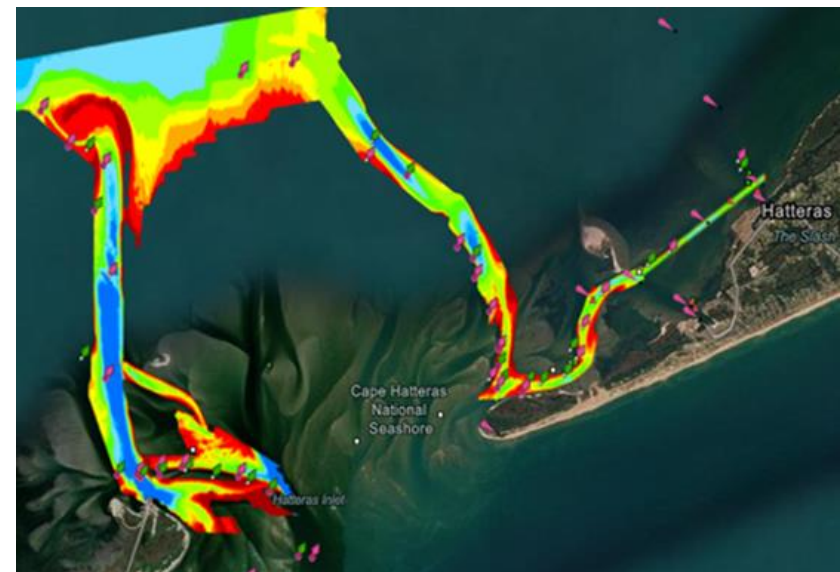
Waterways Management

- CGC SMILAX (Pilings)
- CGC MAPLE (Offshore/Major Aids)

Challenges

- Constant shoaling / shifts
- Determining good water around shallow water inlets





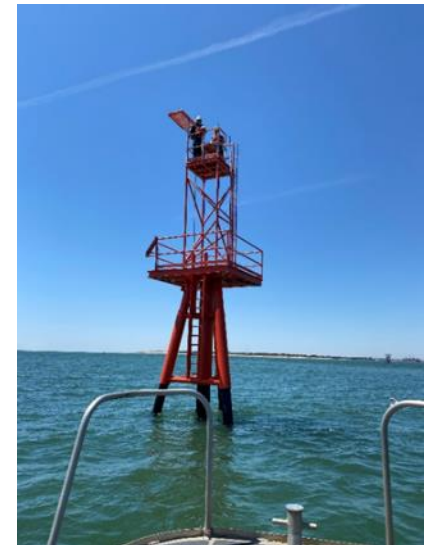
Hurricanes & Heavy Weather
